Attempt any one of the following tasks:

Task: Create a Weather Report Animation in Scratch [20]

Instructions:

Create a short animation in Scratch where a weather reporter talks about the current weather and forecast for the next day.

Requirements:

- Use two different sprites (e.g., weather reporter and sun/cloud).

- Add a background that matches the theme (e.g., city, studio, outdoor).
- Use the “say” block to show a 2-line weather report and a 2-line forecast.
- Use “wait” blocks to create a realistic pause between sentences.
- Add weather-related sound effects (e.g., rain, thunder, or sunshine).
- Switch costumes for visual effect (e.g., sun becomes cloudy).
- Change background during the report (e.g., from current day to forecast).
- Add a repeat block that simulates a flashing news sign.
- Make both sprites glide or move into view.

Task: Library Book Checkout Record

Scenario:

You are helping to maintain a digital record of books checked out from the school library. Create a spreadsheet to log checkout information for students.

Create a spreadsheet with the following columns:

Data Entry

- Enter records for 3 students.
- Each record should include: Student's name, Book title, Category, and Quantity (number of books borrowed).

Data Validation

- In the **Category** column, create a drop-down list with the following options:
 - Fiction, Non-Fiction, Reference

Calculated Field

- Use a formula in the **Total Pages** column to calculate:

- Total Pages = Quantity × Average Pages per Book

Logical Test

- In the **Heavy Reader?** column, use an IF function to check:
 - If the total pages exceed 500, show **“Yes”**, otherwise show **“No”**.
