

Active/Passive Voice Conversion Rules

To assist students in remembering the rules for converting between active and passive voice, consider the following mnemonic device: "SVO to OVS"

- SVO (Subject-Verb-Object) to OVS (Object-Verb-Subject):
 - Active Voice: Subject performs the action on the Object.
 - Example: The chef (Subject) cooks (Verb) the meal (Object).
 - o **Passive Voice:** Object becomes the focus; the action is performed by the Subject.
 - Example: The meal (Object) is cooked (Verb) by the chef (Subject).

Steps for Conversion:

- 1. **Identify** the Subject, Verb, and Object in the active sentence.
- 2. **Move** the Object to the beginning to become the new Subject of the passive sentence.
- 3. **Change** the Verb to the appropriate form of "to be" + past participle.
- 4. Add the original Subject at the end, preceded by "by" (if necessary).

Example Conversion:

- Active: The teacher (Subject) explains (Verb) the lesson (Object).
- Passive: The lesson (Object) is explained (Verb) by the teacher (Subject).

- 5. The new product was released by the company last week.
- 6. A stunning portrait was painted by the artist.
- 7. The computer is being fixed by the technician.
- 8. The project proposal was approved by the manager.
