What is a phrasal verb?

A **phrasal verb** is made up of a verb and one or more small words (such as *up, out, off, on, in*). Together, they make a new meaning.

Phrasal Verb	Meaning	Example
give up	stop trying	Never give up on your dreams.
look after	take care of	Sara looks after her little brother.
turn off	stop a machine/light	Please turn off the fan.
pick up	lift or collect	Please pick up your books.
find out	discover information	I want to find out the answer.
wake up	stop sleeping	I wake up at seven o'clock.
put on	dress in something	Put on your jacket.
take off	remove something	Take off your shoes.
look for	try to find	We are looking for the missing key.
come back	return	Please come back before lunch.
