What are Quantifiers?

Quantifiers are words that tell us how much or how many of something there is. Examples: some, many, much, few, little, all, no.

Quantifier	Example Sentence
Some	I have some apples.
Many	There are many stars in the sky.
Much	She drank much water.
Few	There are few cookies left.
Little	I have little milk.
