### What is a Play Script?

A **play script** is written for actors to perform on stage.  
It tells us:

- Who is speaking
  - What they are saying
  - What they are doing
- 



### Features of a Play Script

- ✓ Title
  - ✓ Characters list
  - ✓ Dialogue (what the characters say)
  - ✓ Character names in CAPITAL letters
  - ✓ Colon (:) after the character's name
  - ✓ Stage directions (in brackets)
  - ✓ No long paragraphs like stories
-
